Let's Knit in Latgale!

From August 1st to August 5th, 2022 around Latgale, Latvia

Workshop languages: Latvian / English

Participation fee: 675, - eur

Participation fee includes-Transportation from Rīga to Pļaviņas, Rezekne, Baltinava -Balvi, Preiļi - Lūznava, Līvāni and back to Riga. Four nights at a comfortable three star hotel in Rezekne on a shared Twin room basis*. All meals, tea and coffee breaks. All necessary yarns and needles for the workshops.

5-day knitting tour around one of Latvia's most picturesque regions—Latgale, called "blue lake land". Museum visits, applied art exhibitions, Latgalian ceramics, traditions and skills. Workshops with the local knitting masters.
